CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT relating to special taxes and assessments on real estate owned by the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Real estate owned or held in trust exempt. SECTION 1. No real estate belonging to or held in trust for this state, exempt from taxation by the laws of this state, shall be subject to special taxes or assessments for local improvements.

Conflicting laws repealed. SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts and all provisions of city charters inconsistent with or contravening any of the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT to amend section 439a of the statutes of 1898, relating to the compulsory education of school children.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

School age increased. SECTION 1. Section 439a, of the statutes of 1898, is hereby amended by striking out the word "thirteen" in the second line after the word "and" in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fourteen."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
