CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to amend section 1458a, of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, as amended by chapter 48 laws of Wisconsin for 1899 relating to duties of the Wisconsin state board of agriculture.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Jurisdiction and duties of board. SECTION 1. Section 1458a, of the Wisconsin statutes, as amended by chapter 48 of the laws of 1899, is further amended as follows: In the last paragraph of such section strike out the words "even-numbered," so that such section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 1458a. Said board may occupy such rooms in the capitol as may be assigned for that purpose by the governor. They shall have sole control of the affairs of the department of agriculture and of all state fairs and state fair grounds, and may make such by-laws, rules and regulations in relation to the management of the business of such department and said fairs and the offering of premiums thereat, as they shall from time to time determine. The board shall make a report of their action to the governor on or before the first day of December in each year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

Fee for filing notices of births. SECTION 1. Section 1024b of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, is hereby amended as follows:
