CHAPTER 217.

AN ACT relating to the appropriation made by section 2, of chapter 399, of the laws of 1903.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Unexpended balance of appropriation to be paid to commission. SECTION 1. The state treasurer is directed to pay the unexpended balance of the appropriation made by section 2, chapter 399, laws of 1903, to the commission existing under such law, taking the receipt of its president and secretary therefor.

Members of commission responsible for money so paid. SECTION 2. The members of the commission shall be responsible for the money paid as aforesaid and shall account therefor to the secretary of state in vouchers for money paid for expenses incurred by them in the execution of such chapter and in cash by the first day of June, 1905. The cash so received by such secretary of state shall be by him upon its reception paid to the state treasurer, who shall cover the same into the general fund.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
