CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to authorize the village board of the village of Pewaukee, Waukesha county, Wisconsin, to fill in at the foot of Pewaukee lake for the purpose of widening Main street and improving navigation, and to erect docks and piers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Village board authorized to fill in lake, build docks and piers.

SECTION 1. The village board of the village of Pewaukee, Waukesha county, Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to fill in at the foot of Pewaukee lake, where it abuts upon Main street in said village, to a distance in said lake, not to exceed 100 feet, for the purpose of widening Main street and improving navigation; and said village board is also authorized to build and maintain such docks and piers, extending into said lake from the said street when filled in, as they shall deem necessary and convenient for the public use.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
