CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to amend section 925—120, statutes of 1898, relating to fiscal year in cities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 925—120, statutes of 1898, is amended to read:

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1st, 1908.

CHAPTER 350.

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money to the normal school fund income to make additions and enlargements to the normal school buildings at River Falls, Oshkosh and Superior.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

River Falls normal: appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to the normal school fund income, the sum of ten thousand dollars for building an addition to the normal school building in the city of River Falls and furnishing and equipping the same. Such money shall be expended in such manner and at such times as in the judgment of the board of regents of normal schools shall seem best.

Oshkosh normal: appropriation. SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to the normal school fund income, the sum of forty thousand dollars for building a new gymnasium and furnishing and equipping the same, and for providing other additional room for the manual training department and domestic science at the normal school in the city of Oshkosh. Such money shall be expended in such manner and at such times, as in the judgment of the board of regents of normal schools shall seem best.

Superior normal: appropriation. SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to the normal school fund income, the sum of forty-five thousand dollars for building an addition to the normal school building in the city of Superior and furnishing and equipping the same. Such money shall be expended in such manner and at such times, as in the judgment of the board of regents of normal schools shall seem best.

Governor's approval prerequisite for plans and contracts. SECTION 4. It is hereby provided that no plan or plans shall be adopted and no contract or contracts shall be entered into by said board of regents for the building of said gymnasium and additions to the normal school buildings until such plan or plans and contract or contracts with the total cost of each, shall have been submitted to, and in writing approved by, the governor of the state, who shall withhold such approval until he shall have satisfied himself by a personal examination of the same and by such other means as he in his discretion may adopt that such buildings and additions can and will be fully completed, according to such plan or plans and contract or contracts, for the amounts hereby provided for each particular purpose.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
