## CHAPTER 419.

AN ACT to repeal section 1496a of the statutes, and to create a new section to be known as section 1496a, relating to the improvement and maintenance of state fish hatcheries, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1496a of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 1496a. 1. There is appropriated to the commissioner of fisheries out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting and equipping buildings and making other improvements at the state fish hatchery at Wild Rose.

2. There is appropriated to the commissioner of fisheries out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of thirty-seven thousand dollars annually for maintaining and operating the state fish hatcheries.

SECTION 3. Chapter 9 of the laws of 1889 and Chapter 133 of the laws of 1895 and all other acts or parts of act conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 420.

AN ACT to create section 1455a of the statutes relating to cemeteries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read:

Section 1455a. 1. Any cemetery association or religious society incorporated under the laws of this state and owning or maintaining a cemetery or burial ground in or near to a city having, by the last preceding state or United States census, a population of over 100 000 is hereby authorized and empowered, subject to the provisions of section 1454, to ac-
