## CHAPTER 5.

AN ACT to amend section 2424 of the statutes, relating to the term of court in the ninth judicial circuit.

Ninth Circuit. In the county of Dane, on the second Monday in January, the third Monday in \* \* \* April, the \* \* \* first Monday in June, and the second Monday in October; in the county of Sauk, on the third Tuesday in \* \* \* March. the \* \* \* first Tuesday in September and the first Tuesday in December. No jury shall be summoned for the term to be held in the month of \* \* \* June in said county of Dane.

## CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to make an appropriation for conducting the investigation provided for in Joint Resolution No. 3, S.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum not to exceed five thousand dollars to cover and defray the expenses which may be incurred by the joint committee of investigation appointed pursuant to Joint Resolution No. 3, S., heretofore adopted, in carrying out the provisions of said resolution.
