CHAPTER 634.

AN ACT to amend subsections 2 and 3 of section 376 of the statutes, and to create a new subsection of section 376 of the statutes, all relating to the state historical society, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsections 2 and 3 of section 376 of the statutes are amended to read: (Section 376.) 2. And for the purpose of aiding in the performance of said duties, and for heating, lighting, and otherwise maintaining the state historical library building there is hereby annually appropriated to said society the sum of twenty * * * seven thousand dollars. Any balance of said annual appropriation not expended in any one year may be added to the expenditures of the next ensuing year.

3. For the purpose of purchasing books, periodicals, maps, manuscripts, and kindred articles for its reference library, there is hereby annually appropriated to the state historical society of Wisconsin, as trustee of the state, the sum of * * * seven thousand dollars, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. Any balance not expended in any one year may be added to the expenditures of the next ensuing year.

SECTION 2. There is added to section 376 of the statutes a new subsection to read: (Section 376) 5. For the purpose of more efficiently equipping and administering its museum of ethnology, history, and art, and of conducting field research in history within and for the state of Wisconsin, there is hereby annually appropriated to the state historical society of Wisconsin, as trustee of the state, the sum of two thousand dollars out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. Any balance not expended in any one year may be added to the expenditures of the next ensuing year.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
