CHAPTER 99.

AN ACT to create section 937d of the statutes, authorizing cities to build and maintain public buildings.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 937d. 1. The common council of any city, or the village board of any incorporated village, however incorporated, may, by a majority vote of all the members thereof at any general or special meeting, provide for the erection, maintenance, operation, and management of a public auditorium, opera house, or other public recreation and amusement building, and the provisions of law governing the erection of other public buildings in any city erecting any such building under this section, and governing the contracts relating thereto, shall govern in the case of buildings authorized by this section to be erected.

2. The common council of any city in which any such building is erected shall adopt rules and regulations governing the maintenance, operation, and management of such building.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to repeal section 3476 of the statutes, relating to the action of quo warranto.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3476 of the statutes is repealed.
