CHAPTER 155.

AN ACT to repeal sections 1906, 1906a, 1945d, 1945g, 1946, 1978f, 1978g, 1978h, 1978i, 1978j, 1978k, 1978l, and 1978m of the statutes, relating to insurance.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 1906, 1906a, 1945d, 1945g, 1946, 1978f, 1978g, 1978h, 1978i, 1978j, 1978k, 1978l, and 1978m of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 156.

AN ACT to create subsection 12 of section 4560a—12 of the statutes, relating to closed season for fishing in Eagan's Lake in Waushara county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to section 4560a—12 of the statutes a new subsection to read: (Section 4560a—12.) 12. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, or kill in any manner or by any device, any game or rough fish of any kind or variety, in or from Eagan's Lake, situated in the town of Marion in Waushara county, prior to the first day of June, 1916.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
