CHAPTER 240.

AN ACT to amend subsection 2 of section 2216 of the statutes, relating to the execution of conveyances by corporations.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 2 of section 2216 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 2216) 2. When such conveyances are of lands or any interest therein, owned by a corporation organized under any law of this state, they shall be signed by the president or other authorized officers of the corporation, sealed with the corporate seal, if any, otherwise as provided in section 2215, and countersigned by the secretary, assistant secretary or assistant cashier, or clerk thereof; and all corporate conveyances so executed prior to the taking effect of these statutes shall be valid.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to amend section 3329 of the statutes, relating to liens on logs, timber, etc.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3329 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 3329. Any person who shall do or perform any labor or services in cutting, hauling, running, felling, piling, driving, rafting, booming, cribbing, towing, sawing, peeling or manufacturing into lumber or timber any logs, timber, stave bolts, heading, staves, pulp wood, cordwood, firewood, railroad ties, piling, telegraph poles, telephone poles, fence posts, paving timber, tan or other barks or in preparing wood for or manufacturing charcoal shall have a lien upon such material for the amount due or to become due for any such labor or services, which lien shall take precedence of all other claims, liens or incumbrances thereon or sales thereof, whether such claims, liens incumbrances or sales are made, created or accrue before or after the time of doing such work, labor or services.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
