and the requirements of each of said departments as to supporting information shall be as nearly uniform as may be and the pay rolls of each department shall be sworn to by the head or heads thereof and by the clerk in the department making up the said pay roll.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT to create section 925—30a of the statutes and to repeal chapter 380 of the laws of 1909, relating to the power of cities of the first class to fix salaries of their officers and employes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 925—30a. The common council of any city of the first class, whether operating under general or special charter, may at any time within sixty days prior to the first day of December of any year, introduce and pass ordinances fixing and changing the salary of any city officials and employes, the ordinances to go into effect on the first of January thereafter. The salaries of all elective or appointive officers having a definite term shall not be changed during their term of office. The salary of elective officers may be changed within the period hereinbefore stated, to take effect at the end of the term of the incumbent.

Section 2. Chapter 380 of the laws of 1909 is repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
