CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT to create subsection 8 of section 959—35w of the statutes, relating to granting of privileges pertaining to streets by cities, towns and villages.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to section 959—35w of the statutes a new subsection to read: (Section 959—35w.) 8. It shall be unlawful for any city or village in the extension of any improvements authorized by law, or by its said charter, to excavate in, or in any manner obstruct temporarily or otherwise, any street, alley or public place, of any other municipality, without first making application and obtaining the permit hereinbefore provided and required.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT to create section 697—47a of the statutes, authorizing the board of trustees of the county poor in certain counties to receive and care for in the county hospital patients who are not indigent.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 697—47a. Any resident of this state not indigent may be received into, treated and cared for, in the county hospital referred to in section 697—45 upon such terms and conditions and at such rate of pay as may be established and fixed by the board of trustees having charge of such hospital; provided, however, that indigent and destitute sick persons shall be cared for and have preference of admission to such hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
