**CHAPTER 571.**

AN ACT to repeal subsection 1 and to create subsection 1 of section 172—51 of the statutes, making an appropriation for the board of law examiners.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection 1 of section 172—51 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. There is added to section 172—51 of the statutes a new subsection to be numbered and to read: (Section 172—51.) 1. There is annually appropriated, beginning July 1, 1915, two thousand one hundred dollars, payable from any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, for the board of bar examiners to carry into effect the powers, duties and functions provided by law for said board.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made in this act shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to the passage and publication thereof.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

**CHAPTER 572.**

AN ACT to amend subsection 6 of section 925m—308 of the statutes, providing for the selection by the common council of cities under the commission form of government from among their number of some one to act as a member of each board and commission in said city, including the board of education.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection 6 of section 925m—308 of the statutes is amended to read: 6. Upon the first Tuesday in May following the reorganization of any city as provided for in sections 925m—301 to 925m—319, inclusive, and annually thereafter, the council shall select from among their number some one to act as a member of each of such boards and commissions, *including the board of education*. Such members so selected shall have all the power and authority vested by law in any other member of such board or commission, and shall serve as a
