CHAPTER 31

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 20.16 of the statutes making an appropriation for the Wisconsin archeological society.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 20.16 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.16) (3) To the Wisconsin archeological society, annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1917, * * * five hundred * * * dollars, for printing and to otherwise carry on the work of said society; but no part of this appropriation shall be paid out of the state treasury until necessary to pay actual claims duly audited by the secretary of state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.

CHAPTER 32

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 20.15 of the statutes, making an appropriation for memorial hall.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 20.15 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.15) (1) To the custodian of memorial hall, annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1917, * * * two thousand * * * dollars, for the execution of the functions prescribed by sections 376—1 to 376—5 of the statutes. Of this there is allotted to the custodian an annual salary of twelve hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.
