CHAPTER 338

AN ACT to amend subsection 1 of section 1229m of the statutes, relating to the compensation of town superintendents of highways.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 1 of section 1229m of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 1229m) 1. In any town situated in any county having a population of two hundred thousand or over, wherein the county board, at any annual meeting, shall, by a majority vote of all members thereof, have adopted a resolution determining that the provisions of chapter 599, laws of 1911, shall apply to such county, the superintendent of highways of such town may be paid, in lieu of all other compensation, a salary not to exceed one thousand two hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly, out of the bridge and road fund of such town. Such salary shall be fixed by the electors at the annual town meeting. *In addition to such salary, such superintendent of highways of such town, may be paid any part of and not more than six hundred dollars per annum for the maintenance and upkeep of an automobile, provided such superintendent, at his own expense, provides himself with an automobile, suitable to the satisfaction of the supervisors, for use in such position, and equipped with truck attachment; such payment to be in addition to the salary of such superintendent of highways, and to be paid monthly, out of the bridge and road fund of said town. Such payment for the upkeep of an automobile, shall be fixed by the supervisors at any regular meeting, and may be discontinued by them, if at any time, in their discretion they determine so to do, and the right to receive payment for the upkeep of such automobile, shall not be incidental to or inseparable from such office of superintendent of highways, but may be allowed or discontinued by the supervisors, in their discretion, at any meeting of such supervisors.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
