

creased or diminished by any executive or administrative officer, and the same shall be apportioned by the secretary of state to the several counties, and be apportioned according to law by the several county clerks of such counties to the taxing districts therein and be collected and accounted for according to law.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 583

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) and the first paragraph of subsection (3) of section 20.33 of the statutes, relating to the state board of industrial education, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) and the first paragraph of subsection (3) of section 20.33 of the statutes, are amended to read:

(20.33) (1) *Annually, beginning July 1, 1917, not to exceed ten thousand two hundred fifty dollars, for the administrative expenses of the board. Of this there is allotted:*

(a) To each appointed member of the board a compensation of one hundred dollars per year and actual and necessary traveling expenses.

(b) *Such sums as may be necessary for office supplies.*

(3) The remainder shall be distributed for state aid for
 • • • *vocational* schools established and maintained pursuant to subsection 1 of section 553p—3 of the statutes, and any school once granted such state aid shall be entitled thereto as long as the character of its work meets with the approval of the state board of industrial education, as follows:

SECTION 2. Subsection (2) of section 20.33 of the statutes is renumbered to be paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 20.33.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.
