The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2523—22 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 2523—22. No judge of any court of record in this state \* • • shall be eligible to or hold any office of public trust, except a judicial office, during the term for which he is elected, and all votes cast for any such judge for any office, except a judicial office, shall be void.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

- AN ACT to creaté section 560m of the statutes, relating to the apportionment of special state aid to first-class rural schools and special state aid for transportation for the year ending June 30, 1917.
- The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 560m. All special state aid for first-class rural schools for the year ending June 30, 1917, and all state aid on account of transportation of children to and from school for the year ending June 30, 1917. in accordance with sections 419e to 419h, inclusive, 430—1 to 430—8, inclusive, 496—9 to 496—12, inclusive, 496q to 496t, inclusive, and subsection 7 of section 496e, statutes of 1915, shall be apportioned and paid in accordance with the provisions of the statutes of 1915.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1917.
