CHAPTER 672

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 601, laws of 1917, by supplying an omission therein.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 601, laws of 1917, is amended to read: (Ch. 601, 1917) Section 2. The state conservation commission is authorized *with the consent and approval of the governor and the direction of the chief engineer* to grant a right-of-way for construction of *and to construct* a spur track from the proposed new quarry site to the *main line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway*, same to cross the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 19 in township 11, north of range 7 east, in order to make accessible the lands so purchased for exchange.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 673

AN ACT to validate village bonds authorized to be issued by the electors and validating all action in connection therewith and authorizing the issuance of such bonds.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever the qualified electors of any village shall heretofore have authorized, in accordance with the provisions of section 943 of the statutes, the issuance of the bonds of such village for any of the purposes mentioned in section 919cc of the statutes, the president and trustees may borrow money therefor to the amount of five per cent of the ~~assessed~~ valuation of the real and personal property in such village and issue negotiable bonds therefor in the manner provided in said section 919cc.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
