CHAPTER 316.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money named herein to reimburse Louis A. Arnold for expenses incurred in a contest to determine the right to a seat in the senate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to Louis A. Arnold out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two hundred and ninety-seven dollars and fifty-five cents to reimburse him in full for all expenses incurred by him in the contest to determine his right to a seat in the senate at this session of the legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (c) of subsection (26) of section 20.17 of the statutes, relating to county tuberculosis institutions, and making appropriations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (26) of section 20.17 of the statutes is amended to read: (20.17) (26) (c) For the fiscal year ending June 30, * * 1920, not to exceed * * two hundred ten thousand dollars, and for the fiscal year ending June 30, * * 1921, not to exceed * * two hundred ten thousand dollars, for state aid to county tuberculosis institutions, to be credited on taxes, as provided in section 1421—14 of the statutes. Such aid shall be apportioned among the various county institutions in proportion to the number of patients cared for at public expense in each institution during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June; but no more shall be allowed than * * seven dollars per week per patient for the number of weeks such patient was a resident of such institution.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1919. Approved June 7, 1919.
