(20.41) (3) (o) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1919, five thousand dollars, provided that the county board of Door county appropriate a similar amount on or before July 1, 1919; for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1920, twelve thousand dollars, to carry out the provisions of section 36.225.

### CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 20.62 of the statutes, relating to salaries of justices of the supreme court.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 20.62 is amended to read: (20.62) (1) To each justice of said court whose term of office commenced prior to the 1st day of July, \* \* \* 1919, an annual salary of \* \* \* seven thousand five hundred dollars; and to each justice whose term of office commenced thereafter, an annual salary of \* \* \* eight thousand five hundred dollars. *The justice serving as chief justice, as provided by law, shall receive an additional salary of five hundred dollars per annum, during the period of such service.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
