CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to create section 1047c of the statutes, relating to the platting of lands outside the limits of an incorporated city and validating maps and plats thereof.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: Section 1047c. Wherever in counties containing a city of the second class, lands have been platted under the provisions of section 1047a and the plat thereof embraced more than forty acres and has been recorded, such plat is hereby validated and confirmed and no action shall hereafter be brought or maintained to annul or set aside such plat unless the same be commenced within three months after this act takes effect.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
