CHAPTER 261.

AN ACT to create subsection (10a) of section 20.20 of the statutes, relating to the establishment of a fish hatchery in either Racine, Kenosha or Walworth county and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 20.20 of the statutes to read: (20.20) (10a) On July 1, 1927, a sum not to exceed ten thousand dollars for the purchase of land and the construction of necessary buildings and making investigations to determine the proper location for a state fish hatchery in either Racine, Kenosha or Walworth county.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 262.

AN ACT to appoint a committee in this state to act jointly with a similar committee of the state of Minnesota in the investigation of port conditions at the port of Superior-Duluth, and to submit to the governor of this state a comprehensive report recommending the proper policy that shall be pursued for the best interests of the entire port of Superior-Duluth, and the legislation, state, federal and municipal, that will be necessary to make such recommendations effective, and authorizing an appropriation by the city within which said port of Superior-Duluth is located to defray the expenses of said committee.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The governor of this state, on the taking effect of this act, shall appoint a committee of three who shall have the power on the part of the state of Wisconsin to meet with a similar committee appointed, or who may be appointed under and by virtue of a law of the state of Minnesota, to negotiate or agree upon a joint report, recommending a policy to be pursued by the
