CHAPTER 328.

AN ACT to renumber subsection (18) to be subsection (19) and to create subsection (18) of section 59.07 of the statutes, relating to powers of counties.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (18) of section 59.07 of the statutes is renumbered to be subsection (19) of said section.

SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 59.07 of the statutes to be numbered and to read: (59.07) (18) For the enforcement of all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations enacted pursuant to the provisions of section 59.97, appoint a building inspector, define his duties and fix his term of office and compensation. The jurisdiction of said building inspector, however, shall not extend over any lands actually used for agricultural purposes.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 329.

AN ACT to amend section 253.11 of the statutes, relating to county judges holding court in counties other than those in which they have been elected.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 253.11 of the statutes is amended to read: 253.11 The county judges may perform all official duties of county judges, including holding court in any county other than the one in which they shall have been elected, upon the request of the county judge of such other county, *and upon the request of the judge of the circuit court for such other county in case of the total disability or death of the county judge of such other county*, and while so doing they shall have the same powers as if elected for the county in which they are acting.
