six months after such annuitant temporarily has ceased active teaching service. No annuity, except the temporary incapacity annuity provided for in paragraph (d) of subsection (12) of this section, shall be paid to any person until such person shall have retired from teaching service in the public schools to which this section applies and all applications for annuity and proofs in support thereof shall be filed with the board of trustees within one year after the applicant retires from teaching service in such city, except that the temporary incapacity annuity provided for in paragraph (d) of subsection (12) of this section may be applied for, allowed and paid as therein provided before the recipient thereof has retired from teaching service in such city. No teacher shall be deemed to have retired from teaching service until such teacher shall have resigned from his position or the managing body of the schools of such city legally shall have caused such teacher's name to be stricken from the official list of teachers.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 366.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the custodian of memorial hall for the execution of the functions prescribed in sections 45.01 to 45.04 inclusive, as an emergency appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the custodian of memorial hall two hundred dollars for operation in addition to all other appropriations heretofore made for that purpose, for the execution of the functions prescribed by sections 45.01 to 45.04 inclusive, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
