

and amount to a list to be certified to them by the commissioner of banking or his deputies. Such bank or banking corporation may, with the consent of the commissioner, resume business upon such conditions as may be approved by him.

SECTION 2. Two new subsections are added to section 220.08 of the statutes to read: (220.08) (15) Whenever it shall appear to the commissioner of banking that the books and records of any liquidated bank or banking corporation are no longer required by him, he may turn the same over to the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which such liquidated bank was located.

(16) Whenever any bank or banking corporation has been completely liquidated, the commissioner of banking shall and he is hereby authorized to cancel the charter of such bank or banking corporation.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 492.

AN ACT to repeal subsections (6a), (9), (13), (17), (18), (19), (20), and (21) of section 20.20 of the statutes; to amend subsections (1), (2), (3), (8), and (12) of section 20.20 of the statutes; and to create a new subsection (6c) to section 20.20 of the statutes, relating to appropriations for the state conservation commission.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsections (6a), (9), (13), (17), (18), (19), (20), and (21) of section 20.20 of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 2. Subsections (1), (2), (3), (8), and (12) of section 20.20 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.20) (1) * * * *Annually, beginning July 1, 1927, four hundred fifty-eight thousand eight hundred ninety-two dollars for administration and operation. Of this there is allotted:*

(a) *To general administration, forty-two thousand nine hundred thirty-three dollars.*

(b) *To forestry and fire protection, including forestry extension and carrying out the provisions of section 26.125, sixty-seven thousand four hundred dollars.*

(c) *To the care and supervision of state parks, twenty-three thousand eight hundred five dollars.*

(d) *To salaries, traveling and other expenses of conservation wardens and other functions and duties imposed upon or assigned to this division, two hundred fourteen thousand one hundred forty dollars.*

(e) *To the fishery division, including fish rescue work and distribution of rescued fish, one hundred ten thousand six hundred fourteen dollars.*

(2) On July 1, * * * 1927, * * * *twenty-eight thousand * * * eight hundred twenty-five dollars*; and on July 1, * * * 1928, * * * *twenty-seven thousand * * * two hundred * * * sixty-five dollars*; for property repairs and maintenance.

(3) On July 1, * * * 1927, * * * *eighty-nine thousand * * * six hundred * * * twenty-five dollars*, and on July 1, * * * 1928, * * * *fifty-one thousand * * * one hundred fifty dollars*, for permanent property and improvements.

(8) All moneys received by the state conservation commission from the United States under the provisions of an act of congress * * * known as the * * * "*Clark-McNary Law*," for fire prevention and control, *forest planting and other forestry activities*, shall be paid into the conservation fund within one week of receipt and are appropriated *respectively* to the state conservation commission *for the purposes for which they are received* * * * .

(12) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1927, * * * *fourteen thousand five hundred dollars* for growing desirable Wisconsin forest trees at the state forest nursery at Trout lake, Wisconsin, such trees to be distributed to farmers and other Wisconsin landowners for planting in Wisconsin under the direction of and on such terms as the conservation commission may determine, *and for the direct planting of trees by the conservation commission.*

SECTION 3. There is added a new subsection (6c) to section 20.20 of the statutes to read: (20.20) (6c) On July 1, 1927, five thousand dollars as a revolving appropriation for establishing and furnishing in the state parks, at a reasonable charge, such

services, conveniences and recreational facilities as will render such parks more attractive to tourists and the general public and increase the number of visitors thereto. All moneys received from such services, conveniences and recreational facilities shall be paid, within one week after receipt, into the conservation fund and are appropriated therefrom and added to and made a part of this appropriation.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1927.

CHAPTER 493.

AN ACT to amend subsection (5a) of section 20.49 of the statutes, relating to the improvement of highways forming connections between state charitable and penal institutions and the state trunk highway system; and to create paragraph (j) to subsection (10), paragraph (g) to subsection (13), and paragraph (d) to subsection (18), all of section 20.17 of the statutes, relating to appropriations for the state prison, the industrial school for boys, and the workshop for blind.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (5a) of section 20.49 of the statutes is amended to read: (20.49) (5a) On July 1, 1925, and annually thereafter, twenty-five thousand dollars for improving highways forming the most convenient connection between state charitable or penal institutions, and the state trunk highway system, *or to construct roadways under or over state trunk highways that pass through the grounds of any state charitable or penal institution.* All work under this subsection shall be determined jointly with the state board of control.

SECTION 2. A new paragraph (j) to subsection (10), paragraph (g) to subsection (13), and paragraph (d) to subsection (18), all of section 20.17 of the statutes are created to read: (20.17) (10) (Old (18)) (j) On July 1, 1927, ten thousand dollars and on July 1, 1928, ten thousand dollars for the construction and equipment of buildings on the north farm.
