CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to create subsection (5a) of section 40.34 of the statutes, relating to transportation of school children.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 40.34 of the statutes to read: (40.34) (5a) Whenever in the judgment of the board it is to the interest of the district in lieu of transportation to rent a house for the family of children required to be transported, it may enter into a written lease for such house and pay as rental therefor not more than the amount which would have to be paid for transportation pursuant to subsection (3).

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend section 301.36 of the statutes, relating to offer of judgment in justice court.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 301.36 of the statutes is amended to read: 301.36 At or before the time of joining issue or on any day to which the case may be adjourned, in * * * any action, * * * any defendant may offer in writing to permit the plaintiff to take judgment against him for the sum, damages or things stated in said offer, with costs; if the plaintiff accept such offer he shall make such acceptance in writing, and such offer and acceptance shall be filed with the justice and thereupon, if the justice shall be satisfied that the action was brought in good faith and without collusion of the parties thereto, for the ascertainment of which he may examine them and witnesses on oath, he shall enter judgment accordingly. The entry of such judgment shall not prejudice the right of the plaintiff to proceed to trial and judgment against any other defendant in said action.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
