CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT to create subsection (4) of section 98.09 of the statutes, relating to the standard to be employed in paying for milk or cream.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 98.09 of the statutes to read: (98.09) (4) Whenever milk is sold under an agreement, express or implied, that the value of the same shall be determined by its proportion of butter fat, the price to be paid shall be based on a three and five-tenths per cent butter fat standard.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT continuing the interim committee on the pollution of the boundary waters of the upper Mississippi river, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The interim investigating committee appointed under joint resolution No. 17 of the legislative session of 1925 to investigate the problem of the pollution of boundary waters between the states of Minnesota and Wisconsin, which committee was continued by joint resolution No. 68 of the legislative session of 1927, is hereby continued and there is appropriated from any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to enable such committee to complete its work, but not to exceed five hundred dollars, and the unexpended balance of the appropriation made to such committee by chapter 254 of the laws of 1925. Payment under this appropriation shall be made upon certification of the chairman of the committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
