CHAPTER 340.

AN ACT to repeal subsection (2) of section 215.19 of the statutes (created in chapter 171, laws of 1931), relating to foreclosure actions by building and loan associations.

CHAPTER 341.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Worden-Allen Company in settlement of its claim against the state arising out of a contract entered into for the construction of a bridge across the Wisconsin river near Muscoda.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is allotted from the appropriation made in subsection (5) of section 20.49 of the statutes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1931, to the Worden-Allen Company of Milwaukee, thirty thousand dollars in settlement of its claim against the state arising out of its contract entered into with the state on August 5, 1927, for the construction of a concrete and steel bridge over and across the Wisconsin river near the village of Muscoda, Grant county. Acceptance of this sum of money shall operate as a full and complete discharge to the state of any claim of the Worden-Allen Company and of its sub-contractor, the Joseph McCarthy Construction Company of Kaukauna, arising under said contract dated August 5, 1927.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1931. Approved June 25, 1931.
