CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT to amend subsection (8) of section 67.12 of the statutes, relating to temporary borrowing by school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (8) of section 67.12 of the statutes is amended to read: (67.12) (8) The school board of any school district operating under the district system may on their own motion, made and properly recorded at a lawful board meeting, borrow money in such sums as are needed to meet the immediate expenses of maintaining the schools in such district. No such loan or loans *except loans made by town boards to school districts* shall be made to extend beyond the * * * *first day of May following* nor to an amount exceeding one-half the * * * *estimated receipts as certified by the state superintendent of schools and the local school clerk*. All such loans shall be secured by lawfully authorized and drawn school orders, each order when paid to be received and returned to the treasurer of the board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT to amend subsection (5) of section 59.98 of the statutes, relating to reforestation by counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (5) of section 59.98 of the statutes is amended to read: (59.98) (5) Any county having established and maintaining a county forest reserve under the provisions of this section and having entered the same under the forest crop law shall receive from the state an amount equal to ten cents for each acre of land within such forest reserve, to be used for the purchase, development, preservation and maintenance of such forest reserve. On or before the * * * *thirtieth day of * * * June* of each year the county clerk or town clerk shall certify to

the state treasurer the number of acres included within the forest reserve of his county together with the legal description of such forest reserve, and the state treasurer shall pay to such county the amount due to it as state aid on or before the * * * following thirty-first day of * * * March * * * , except that payment on lands entered under the forest crop law prior to January 1, 1933 shall be made in May, 1933, and on lands entered in 1933 payment shall be made in March, 1934.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT to create section 132.16 of the statutes, relating to registration and use of insignia of various organizations, and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to be numbered and to read: 132.16 REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATE, FEES, PENALTY. (1) Any association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or association, historical, military, or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization or association, degree, branch, subordinate lodge, or auxiliary thereof, whether incorporated or unincorporated, the principles and activities of which are not repugnant to the constitution and laws of the United States or of this state, may register, in the office of the secretary of state, a facsimile, duplicate, or description of its name, badge, motto, button, decoration, charm, emblem, rosette or other insigne, and may, by reregistration, alter or cancel the same.

(2) Application for such registration, alteration, or cancellation, shall be made by the chief officer or officers of said association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or associations, historical, military, or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization, or association, degree, branch,
