CHAPTER 56.

AN ACT to create section 6.595 of the statutes, relating to election returns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: 6.595 ELECTION RETURNS, REPORTING. The chairman of the inspectors, or one of them appointed by such chairman, shall immediately after the votes are tabulated or counted at each general or primary election report the returns of such election to the county clerk or county election commissioner, who shall immediately upon the receipt thereof make the same public. Such county clerk or election commissioner shall keep his or its office open for such purpose and shall post all returns received in the same order that the names of the candidates or special questions appear on the ballot.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT to create paragraph (n) of subsection (1) of section 67.04 of the statutes, relating to bond issues to enable counties to carry delinquent tax certificates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new paragraph is added to subsection (1) of section 67.04 of the statutes to read: (67.04) (1) (n) To raise a fund for the purpose of enabling the county to carry delinquent tax certificates.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
