CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to renumber and amend 43.08 (3) of the statutes, relating to commissioner on uniform state laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Subsection (3) of section 43.08 is renumbered section 14.76 of the statutes and amended to read:

14.76 * * * The revisor of statutes *and the chief of the legislative reference library* shall * * * represent * * * this state in the national conference of commissioners on uniform state laws. *They* * * * shall examine * * * subjects on which uniformity of legislation in the different states is desirable; ascertain the best means to effect uniformity; * * * co-operate *with commissioners of other states* in the consideration and drafting of uniform acts for submission to the legislatures of the several states; and prepare bills adapting such uniform acts to our statutes for introduction in the legislature.

CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT to authorize the persons therein named to construct and maintain jetties from certain lands in Kenosha county into Lake Michigan.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The owners of the following lands are authorized to construct and maintain 2 or more jetties extending therefrom into Lake Michigan for the purpose of protecting the shore line of such lands, to wit: Lots 49 and 50 in Chiwaukee subdivision located in section 32, township 1 north, range 23 east of the fourth principal meridian, town of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha county, Wisconsin, according to the filed and recorded plat and survey of said subdivision in the office of the register of deeds of said county.
