CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT to create 65.90 and 73.03 (14) (c) of the statutes, relating to governmental budgets.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 65.90 of the statutes is created to read: 65.90 MUNICIPAL BUDGETS. (1) Each county other than counties having a population of 300,000 or more, each city, village, town, school district and all other public bodies that have the power to levy or certify a general property tax or budget shall annually, prior to the determination of the sum to be financed in whole or in part by a general property tax, formulate a budget and hold public hearings thereon.

- (2) Such budget shall list all anticipated revenue from all sources during the ensuing year and shall likewise list all proposed expenditures for each department or activity during the said ensuing year. Such budget shall also show comparable figures for the 2 preceding years.
- (3) A summary of such budget and notice of the place where such budget in detail is available for public inspection and notice of the time and place for holding the public hearing
