### CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT to amend 104.08 (1) of the statutes, relating to apprentices.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

104.08 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

104.08 (1) All \* \* \* *persons* working in an occupation for which a living-wage has been established for minors, and who shall have no trade, shall, if employed in an occupation which is a trade industry, be indentured under the provisions of section 106.01.

### CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT to create 343.329 of the statutes, relating to the misbranding of lubricating oils, lubricants and mixtures of lubricants, and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

343.329 of the statutes is created to read:

343.329 MISBRANDING OF LUBRICATING OILS AND LUBRICANTS. Any person, firm, corporation or organization who or which makes for sale, or sells, or offers to sell or dispose of or has in his, her or its possession with intent to sell or dispose of any lubri-

cating oil, lubricants or mixtures of lubricants which are falsely labeled in any particular, or any such person, firm, corporation or association who sells or offers to sell or dispose of or has in his, her or its possession with intent to sell or dispose of any reclaimed, re-refined, recleaned or previously used lubricating oils, lubricants or mixtures of lubricants without having such product plainly labeled in letters not less than 2 inches high on all bulk containers and letters equal in size to the largest letters appearing on all sealed containers as reclaimed, and that all advertisements, signs or posters advertising reclaimed, re-refined, recleaned or previously used lubricating oils, lubricants or mixtures of lubricants shall contain the word reclaimed in letters equal in size to the largest letters appearing in advertisement, sign or poster, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$500 or by imprisonment not exceeding 3 months, or both at the discretion of the court.

### CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to amend 208.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to payments of benefits for disability of members of fraternal benefit societies.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

208.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

208.09 (1) Any fraternal benefit society may admit to beneficial membership such persons under such conditions and for such benefits as its laws may prescribe, subject to the limitations prescribed under chapter 208 \* \* \* and may in like manner admit general or social members. *Any such society may provide in its laws for the payment to its members of benefits for the disability of such members, their minor children and their spouses.*
