CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT to create 66.05 (10) (ab) of the statutes, relating to fermented malt beverages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.05 (10) (ab) of the statutes is created to read:

66.05 (10) (ab) CONTENTS OF FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES DURING THE WAR EMERGENCY. 1. For the period terminating as provided in subsection (10) (ab) 3. the provisions of subsection (10) (a) 10. shall be superseded by the provisions of subsection (10) (ab) 2.

- 2. "Fermented malt beverages" shall mean any liquor or liquid capable of being used for beverage purposes, made by the alcoholic fermentation of an infusion in potable water of barley malt and hops, with or without unmalted grains or decorticated and degerminated grains or sugar containing one-half of one per cent or more of alcohol by volume.
- 3. The provisions of subsection (10) (ab) 2. shall terminate 6 months after the termination of the present war as declared by the President or the Congress of the United States. Upon the termination of such 6-month period the provisions of subsection (10) (a) 10. shall again be in effect.

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT to amend certain sections of the statutes, relating to the department of public welfare, for the purpose of harmonizing the language of the statutes with the 1939 reorganization of that department and deleting some obsolete provisions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Except in chapter 46 and sections 36.227, 58.31 to 58.40 and 326.23, and except as otherwise provided in this act, wherever in the statutes the terms "state board of control" or "board of control" or "state pension department" are used,
