CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to amend subsection 1 of section 1 of chapter 219, laws of 1927, relating to the jurisdiction of the county court of Polk county in civil actions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Subsection 1 of section 1 of chapter 219, laws of 1927, is amended to read:

(Chapter 219, Laws of 1927) Section 1. 1. The said county court shall have and exercise jurisdiction concurrent with and equal to the jurisdiction of the circuit court of said county in all civil actions, suits and proceedings, either at law or in equity, of every kind and nature and in all special proceedings of every kind and nature, except in actions on contract where the debt or balance due, or damages claimed in the complaint exceeds the sum of * * * \$100,000.

CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to create 343.47 (3) of the statutes, relating to shooting domestic animals while hunting and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

343.47 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

343.47 (3) Any person who, while hunting with a gun or bow and arrow, shall wilfully injure or kill any domestic animal or fowl by shooting shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 or imprisoned not more than 6 months, or both.
