## CHAPTER 596.

AN ACT appropriating a sum to complete all necessary legislative business after sine die adjournment of the legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund, in addition to the appropriation made by section 20.01 (9) of the statutes, a sum sufficient to continue the employment of such legislative employes, including members of the staffs of the chief clerk and sergeant at arms of each house, as may be necessary to complete all legislative business after sine die adjournment of the 1947 regular session of the legislature, for not exceeding 30 days, at the compensation provided in section 20.01 of the statutes.

On the effective date of this act, there is appropriated from the general fund to the emergency board a sum not exceeding \$10,000 for the purpose of purchasing painted portraits of the late Governors Goodland and Loomis, and of former Governor Philip F. La Follette and of such other former governors whose portraits the state does not have, at reasonable prices.
