CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to amend 231.33 and to create 323.035 of the statutes, relating to appointment of special trustees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 231.33 of the statutes is amended to read:
231.33 SPECIAL TRUSTEES; APPOINTMENT. * * * If there * * *
is necessary delay in appointing a trustee or issuing letters of trust, * * * or * * *
if it * * * appears to the court to be necessary, the * * court may appoint a special trustee to act until the matter causing the delay * * is disposed of or the necessity therefor * * * ceases to exist. No appeal shall be allowed from the appointment of such special trustee, and * * * the appointment may be made without notice.

* * He may be removed whenever the court * * * so * * * orders. * * *
The special trustee, before entering upon the duties of his trust, shall give a bond to
* * * the court in such sum and with such sureties as the court * * designates
and * * * approves.

Section 2. 323.035 of the statutes is created to read:

323.035 SPECIAL TRUSTEES; APPOINTMENT. If there is necessary delay in appointing a trustee or issuing letters of trust, or if it appears to the court to be necessary, the court may appoint a special trustee to act until the matter causing the delay is disposed of or the necessity therefor ceases to exist. No appeal shall be allowed from the appointment of such special trustee, and the appointment may be made without notice. He may be removed whenever the court so orders. The special trustee, before entering upon the duties of his trust, shall give a bond to the court in such sum and with such sureties as the court designates and approves.
