CHAPTER 708.

AN ACT to amend 49.26 (7) of the statutes, relating to liens for old-age assistance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

49.26 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

49.26 (7) LIENS, ENFORCEMENT. Such liens shall be enforceable by the county filing the certificate after transfer of title of the real property by conveyance, sale, succession, inheritance or will, in the manner provided for the enforcement of mechanics' liens upon real property; *provided, however, that in any action to foreclose such a lien the statute of limitations shall not be pleaded in defense.* No such lien and no claim under section 49.25 shall be enforced against the homestead of the beneficiary while it is occupied by a surviving spouse or by any surviving minor children, or any incapacitated adult children of the beneficiary.
