CHAPTER 201

AN ACT to create 16.277 of the statutes, relating to seniority credit for classified employes of the state for United States civilian war emergency employment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.277 of the statutes is created to read:

16.277 SENIORITY CREDIT FOR FEDERAL EMPLOYMENT DURING EMERGENCY. Any classified employe on the effective date of this act (1953) who entered the service of the United States in civilian war emergency employment on or after January 1, 1942, and who was not at the time of such entry an employe of the state, and who on November 16, 1946, in accordance with Public Law 549 of the 79th congress was transferred to the service of this state shall have such seniority rights as though he had been a member of the classified service of the state during the period of his employment in the service of the United States.
