CHAPTER 99.

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money for payment of indemnity on animals slaughtered because of Brucellosis infection during the period July 1 to July 15, 1951.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture the sum of \$1,694.11 for distribution to the persons hereinafter named, in the sums set opposite their names, respectively, as payment of indemnity on animals slaughtered because of Brucellosis infection during the period from July 1 to July 15, 1951, a period during which funds were not available to pay such claims because legislative action on Bill No. 221, S. in the 1951 session had not been completed.
