**CHAPTER 18**

AN ACT to amend 1.10 of the statutes, relating to state fish.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

1.10 of the statutes is amended to read:

1.10 STATE TREE, FLOWER, BIRD, FISH. The Wisconsin state tree is the sugar maple (*acer saccharum*); the Wisconsin state flower is the wood violet (*viola papilionacea*); the Wisconsin state bird is the robin (*turdus migratorius*); *the Wisconsin state fish is the muskellunge (Esox masquinongy masquinongy Mitchell).*
