CHAPTER 268

- AN ACT to amend 153.03 (1) and 153.06 (1) of the statutes, relating to the powers and duties of the board of examiners in optometry.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 153.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 153.03 (1) The Wisconsin board of examiners in optometry shall consist of 5 members, appointed by the governor for terms of 5 years, whose

duty it shall be to carry out the purposes and enforce the provisions of this chapter. Each shall have been a resident of this state actively engaged in the practice of optometry for at least 5 years immediately preceding appointment. Each shall make and file an oath of office. The board shall fix the compensation of its members at not more than * * * \$15 for each day actually spent in carrying out their official duties, and actual and necessary expenses. The secretary may receive such additional compensation as the board * * * directs.

Section 2. 153.06 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

153.06 (1) Persons practicing optometry shall annually, before January 1, register with the board and pay a fee of * * * not to exceed \$25 as fixed by the board. The board shall issue certificates of registration expiring the following December 31. The board may permit persons to register later than January 1 but before the following December 31 upon payment of * * * not to exceed \$35 as fixed by the board.
