CHAPTER 5

AN ACT constituting an emergency executive budget bill and making emergency additions and clarification of certain existing appropriations for the fiscal year 1956-1957.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the various state departments and agencies hereinafter designated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957, amounts to supplement the respective appropriations and for the purposes hereinafter set forth:

SECTION 2. As much as is necessary shall be used from the appropriation made in SECTION 1 under s. 20.650 (14) to apply against the deficiency existing in this appropriation for the fiscal year 1955-1956.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision herein or in the statutes contained, s. 20.530 (1) (f) is hereby extended from its expiration date and shall continue in effect until repealed by express legislative act.

SECTION 4. This bill is declared to be an emergency executive budget bill under s. 15.11 (2).
