CHAPTER 68

AN ACT to amend 151.04 (2) of the statutes, relating to operation of drug store by registered assistant pharmacist.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

151.04 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

151.04 (2) No person shall sell, give away, barter, compound or dispense drugs, medicines or poisons, nor permit it, in a town, village or city \* \* \* *having* a population of 500 or more unless he be a registered pharmacist, nor institute nor conduct a place therefor without a registered pharmacist in charge, except that a registered assistant pharmacist may do so under the personal supervision of a registered pharmacist, and may have charge during the pharmacist's necessary absence, not to exceed 10 days. If the population is less than 500, only a registered assistant pharmacist is required *and in such case a registered assistant pharmacist, if otherwise qualified, may continue to operate his drug store, until death or retirement, even though the population increase beyond 500.*
