CHAPTER 691

AN ACT to create 20.005 (2) (a) (line 680a) and 20.670 (61a) of the statutes, relating to authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell certain real estate to the town of Waukesha, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (2) (a) (line 680a) of the statutes is created to read:

20.005 (2) (a)

1957-58 1958-59

680a. Proceeds from sale of land (61a)

SECTION 2. 20.670 (61a) of the statutes is created to read:

20.670 (61a) PROCEEDS FROM SALE OF LAND. The proceeds from the sale of land under ch. 691, laws of 1957, shall be deposited in the general fund and are appropriated therefrom to the state department of public welfare for the farm revolving fund created by sub. (61).

SECTION 3. The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey to the town of Waukesha, for a site for a town hall and fire station and other municipal purposes, at such price and under such terms and conditions as the department shall determine, the following described parcel of land from the grounds of the Wisconsin school for boys, containing 10 acres, adjoining the west line of certain premises owned by one Roy Tenneson, to wit: All that part of the southeast quarter of section 9, town 6 north, range 19 east in the town of Waukesha, Waukesha county, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of said section 9, thence

west along the south line of said section, and the centerline of Sunset Drive 662.97 feet to the southwest corner of land described in volume 282, page 368 of Waukesha county records, to the place of beginning of land herein described; thence north parallel to the east line of said section 9, 1062.60 feet; thence west parallel to the south line of said section 9, 409.94 feet; thence south parallel to the east line of said section, 1062.60 feet to the south section line; thence east along the south line and centerline of Sunset Drive, 409.94 feet to the place of beginning.
