CHAPTER 409

AN ACT to amend 35.84 (9) of the statutes and chapter 312, laws of 1957, section 6, relating to the publication and distribution of the 1960 annotations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 35.84 (9) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.84 (9) Of the * * * 1960 Wisconsin annotations, one copy to each legislator applying therefor and to the committee on judiciary of each house one copy per member * * *, one copy to each standing committee of * * * each house and 60 copies to the state library of which 50 shall be for exchange purposes.

SECTION 2. Chapter 312, laws of 1957, section 6 is amended to read:

(Chapter 312, laws of 1957) Section 6. The revisor of statutes shall prepare and deliver to the director of purchases, as soon as practicable after the end of the regular legislative session of 1959, a printer's copy for a volume to be designated "Wisconsin Annotations" and to contain the Wisconsin constitution, notes of the legislative history of the sections of the statutes and annotations of court decisions interpreting the Wisconsin constitution and statutes, and such other matter as the revisor may deem important. The director shall order printed, and the state printer shall print and deliver, the number of copies ordered. This edition of the annotations shall be printed and published as supplement to the 1959 Wisconsin statutes; and the laws and the contract governing the printing and distribution of those statutes shall, as far as applicable, govern the printing and sale of the annotations, except that the annotations shall be sold at * * * *a price fixed by the director of purchases at approximately the cost thereof* and there shall be no free distribution thereof except as provided in * * * *sections 35.84 (9), 43.13 and 44.06 (1) of the statutes*. The director of purchases shall designate the type, and shall determine the number of copies to be printed.
