CHAPTER 579

AN ACT to amend 944.11 (intro. par.) and 944.12 of the statutes, relating to establishing longer prison terms for sex offenders and abolishing fines therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 944.11 (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:

944.11 (intro. par.) Any of the following may be * * * imprisoned not more than * * * 10 years * * *:

SECTION 2. 944.12 of the statutes is amended to read:

944.12 Any person 18 years of age or over, who, with intent to commit a crime against sexual morality, persuades or entices any child under 18 years of age into any vehicle, building, room or secluded place may be * * * imprisoned not more than * * * 10 years * * *.
