**CHAPTER 645**

**AN ACT** relating to authorizing and directing the state department of public welfare to transfer certain land, therein described, to the state superintendent of public instruction for use in connection with the school for the deaf.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

The state department of public welfare is directed to transfer to the state superintendent of public instruction for use in connection with the school for the deaf, the parcel of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 13, T. 2 N., R. 15 E. of the 4th P. M. Walworth county, Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of state trunk highway No. 11 and the North-South  $\frac{1}{8}$ th Section line of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13; thence S. 75° 17' E. along the centerline of said highway 661.6 feet to the place of beginning; thence N. 14° 43' E. 161.88 feet; thence S. 83° 47' E. 154.20 feet; thence N. 46° 57' E. 126.25 feet; thence S. 82° 32' E. 118.62 feet; thence S. 7° 39' W. 306.20 feet to the centerline of state trunk highway No. 11; thence Northwesterly along the curve of said centerline to a point located N. 76° 18' W. 145.78 feet from the last mentioned point; thence N. 75° 17' W. along the centerline of said highway 229.22 feet to the place of beginning containing 1.89 acres of land more or less.
