## CHAPTER 367

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell and convey a portion of lands of the state connected with the Winnebago state hospital, Winnebago, Wisconsin, and crediting the proceeds therefrom to the appropriation made by section 20.670 (61) of the statutes, and authorizing said department to expend therefrom amounts for the payment of expenses of such sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey, upon such terms, conditions, and covenants as the department shall determine, the following described lands situated in the county of Winnebago, state of Wisconsin, to-wit:

Parcel 444. That portion of the NE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 19 N.,
R. 16 E., described as follows: Commencing at the NE corner

Parcel 472. That portion of the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 19 N., R. 16 E., lying W. of U. S. Highway 41, described as follows: Commencing at the NW corner of said Sec. 35, thence S. along the W. line of Sec. 35 to the centerline of said highway, this point being 975 feet N. of the W1/4 corner of Sec. 35; thence N. 22° 02′ E. along said centerline, 1905 feet to the N. line of said Sec. 35; thence W. along said N. line 717 feet to point of

commencement, containing approximately 12.34 acres which acreage also includes 4.31 acres previously conveyed to the state highway commission for highway purposes. and the proceeds of such sale or sales shall be deposited in the general fund and credited to the revolving fund appropriation in section 20.670 (61) of the statutes, and the department of public welfare is authorized to pay the expenses of such sale or sales out of said revolving appropriation.
